### INTERIOR DESIGN - MADE FOR THE FUTURE

In the hilly vineyards of Lower Austria, there is a successful, visionary symbiosis of architecture and interior design - with an eye for the essential.

"You can't look into the future, but you can lay the foundation for something in the future - because you can build the future," writer Antoine de Saint-Exupery once said. A single-family house with an architectural vision needs to be conceived and planned for the future, because the essential thing is change. A claim that requires a fine interplay between architecture and design and a clear focus on a family's centre of life.

The two striking, white levels of the house, as well as the unusually curved floor plan, define the building in the middle of the Weinviertel region, near the hilly vineyards. They reflect the designand architecture-affine owner's clear commitment to modern architecture implemented by the architectural office "Oberstaller - Sammer".

Incorporating the special architecture of the house and its form into the interior design and integrating it into function as well as form, material and colour was the owner's explicit wish to the designers of STEININGER, who are responsible for interior design and the implementation of the overall concept.







The cool, reduced clarity of the design gives room for freedom - a principle of STEININGER, whose concept focuses on few materials and colours and the repetition of the same. The distinctive wood of the oak floor, for example, is also used on the walls. The central room divider including a fireplace on the ground floor and also the striking relief wall, which runs through the whole house as a red thread, are made of concrete.

On the upper floor, the dark tones were adopted and in the spacious wellness and bathroom area, dark ceramics, glass and harmonious wall tones were added. In the bright building with its continuous glass fronts, finely nuanced contrasts and accents, warm colours and materials give a sense of security and light at the same time. Furniture made-to-measure, furnishings and wall coverings, such as the pure white kitchen island BLOCK, the tall cupboard with herb bed WALL or the central dining table PLUSTABLE on the ground floor, come from the STEININGER manufactory and are complemented by selected design products from brands such as Edra, Vitra, Antonio Lupi, Viso and B&O.

A small masterpiece - the curved room divider with integrated fireplace and a concrete bench - runs through the central living room on the ground floor: from the entrance area with integrated pivot door to the kitchen, further on through the dining room and back to the sofa of the living room. This complex form, oriented on the special round structure of the building, divides the room without taking away its light-flooded openness.

The successful interplay between architecture and design is continued in the outdoor area and in the clear and reduced garden design. Especially in the design of the pool, where the house is reflected, the resulting synergy becomes visible. Bringing the numerous perspectives into harmony is essential for a harmonious overall concept, in which indoor and outdoor areas become one unit,", Jürgen Hamberger, Creative Director at STEININGER says. "It is often enough to change one's perspective, in order to see clear." This quote is also by Antoine de Saint-Exupery.
